

PROHIBITING SHARK – FINNING POLICY

TSP LIVESTOCK & DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (TSP MARINE INDUSTRIES) & DOMINGO TENG FISHING INDUSTRY, INC. does not permit the practice of shark finning aboard its vessels. Shark finning is defined as the removal and retention of any shark fins while discarding the remainder of the shark at sea. The company requires that all sharks, if retained, be stored and landed with their fins naturally attached.

The [MSC 3.0 standard](#) mandates that all retained sharks be landed with their fins still attached to the carcass. It also prohibits the removal of shark fins on board vessels, as well as the retention, transshipment, or landing of removed shark fins.

This policy was adopted on April 1, 2025
